

• End user requirements (*patient, healthcare staff, NHS*): coordination and management with Tay Health Tech partners, drafting documents

- Clinical evaluation strategy: coordination with Tayside Medical Science Centre (TASC), NHS, IGTRF, biostatistics (statistical power)

Meeting to discuss applications


- Reviewers introduce their applications to the group
